Beacon Pointe Subdivision FAQ

Trash Collection • Trash Collection is on Wednesday every week. Trash containers are only to be outside from Tuesday evening until Wednesday evening. If the containers are not kept in a garage the remainder of the time, they must be kept in an approved trash container enclosure.

Pool Information • The pool is an amenity offered only to Beacon Pointe property owners and their guests. It opens in May and closes in early October. • Entry to the pool requires a pool pass tag provided to each property owner. This tag must remain with a member of your party at the pool to verify valid membership when asked. • Access to pool area is limited to property owners in good standing (no balance owed on assessments) • Pool rules are posted at the pool. Access to the clubhouse is through the door with the keypad on it. The code is the same as the four digits of the current year.

Annual Assessments • Annual Assessments are due January 1 each calendar year and are delinquent if paid after January 31. Invoices are emailed unless other arrangements are made with the property manager. Payments may be mailed to: Beacon Pointe Property Owners Association, 1000 Beacon Ridge Dr., Lake Ozark, MO 65049.

Golf Carts within Beacon Pointe are a privilege that residents do not want to lose. Since they are not licensed vehicles, we could lose that privilege if they are not operated in a careful manner. Therefore, it is highly recommended that they only be driven by licensed drivers. Lake Ozark has a golf cart ordinance that requires inspection and allows for use in the subdivision.
